TEMPORARY CLOSURE AND SPEED RESTRICTION OF VARIOUS ROADS
VARIOUS PARISHES
STROUD DISTRICT SPECIAL EVENT ORDER 2019

WHEREAS the Gloucestershire County Council ("the Council") being the Traffic Authority for the various roads as set out in the Schedules below ("the Roads") is satisfied that traffic along the lengths of the roads as defined in Schedule 1 below should be prohibited and the road as defined in Schedule 2 should be restricted for the purpose of facilitating the holding of a relevant event namely The Stroud Half Marathon 2019.

NOW THEREFORE the Council in exercise of its powers under Section 16A of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended by the Road Traffic Regulation (Special Events) Act 1994), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. Except for pedestrian access to properties, no person shall proceed nor cause or permit any vehicle to proceed along the roads as set out in Schedule 1 below;
2. No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to exceed a speed of 30 miles per hour along the road as set out in Schedule 2 below;
3. In this Order –

 "Local Bus" means a Public Service Vehicle used in provision of a Local Service not being an excursion or tour;

 "Local Service" has the meaning given in section 2 of the Transport Act 1985;

 "Motor Vehicle" means a mechanically propelled vehicle intended or adapted for use on the roads as defined in Section 185 of the Road Traffic Act 1988;

 "Public Service Vehicle" has the meaning given in section 1 of the Public Passenger Vehicles Act 1981;

 "Vehicle" means a Motor Vehicle or any other vehicle unless specifically exempted by the provisions of this Order;
4. Nothing in Articles 1 and 2 shall render it unlawful for a vehicle being used for Police, Fire Brigade or Ambulance purposes to proceed along the Roads and at a speed exceeding 30 miles per hour;
5. Nothing in Article 1 shall render it unlawful for a vehicle being used by a statutory undertaker responding to an emergency situation to proceed along the roads as defined in Schedule 1;
6. Nothing in Article 1 shall render it unlawful for a Local Bus to proceed along the road defined in part 4 of Schedule 1;
7. The Roads fall within various Parishes in the Stroud District in the County of Gloucestershire;
8. This Order shall come into operation on the 27th October 2019 and shall continue in force for a period not exceeding 3 days;

9. This Order may be cited as "The Gloucestershire County Council Temporary Closure and Speed Restriction of Various Roads Various Parishes Stroud District Special Event Order 2019".

SPECIAL EVENT NOTICE
VARIOUS ROADS IN VARIOUS PARISHES, STROUD DISTRICT

Gloucestershire County Council has made an Order to prohibit and restrict temporarily under Section 16A of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984, (as amended by the Road Traffic Regulation (Special Events) Act 1994) part of the roads detailed in the Schedules below because it is satisfied that the use of the roads should be either prohibited or restricted for the purpose of facilitating the holding of a relevant event namely the Stroud Half Marathon 2019.

The roads fall within Various Parishes in the Stroud District in the County of Gloucestershire.

The Order comes into force on 27th October 2019 and the roads will be prohibited and restricted on that date on a rolling programme between the hours of 07:30 and 12:30.
